- Continually meet and strive to exceed statutory requirements and industry standards in all jurisdictions within which we operate.
- Continually seek to improve our health, safety and risk management systems and practices.
- Systematically identify and eliminate hazards to reduce both physical and mental health and safety risks.
- Engage and consult with our stakeholders, which includes employees, contractors, consultants, regulators and local communities in the development, implementation and auditing of the health and safety management plan.
- Prioritise regular and relevant training and awareness sessions to promote the values and behaviours critical to ensuring a safe workplace.
- Define and track company performance against health and safety goals and targets.
- Develop, maintain and test emergency response systems and capabilities.

This policy applies to all employees and contractors engaged by Leo and all activities the Company undertakes.
